The Academic Session (July to June) is divided into two Academic Semesters of 20 week each. The curriculum is divided into number of units of instruction called COURSE and course may be cleared by a student at the end of semester in which it is taught/registered/offered.

Course: A course is a unit of instruction or a segment of subject matter to be covered in a semester. It has a course number, title and specified number of credits.

Credit Hours: Each credit represents; one hour lecture in theory or two hours practical in laboratory/field in a week extended to the period of the semester.

Evaluation System

Each course will have specified number of periodical examinations consisting of 1st hourly, mid term, practical and end-of-term examination, etc. Evaluation will be done for each of these components of the examination. Marks of these examinations will be added and converted to percentage of marks obtained by the student in the course.

The cumulative credit points obtained in all the courses from the time of admission at the end of second semester and subsequent divided by the cumulative credit hours in these courses studied is Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA). The OGPA is expressed upto second decimal place.

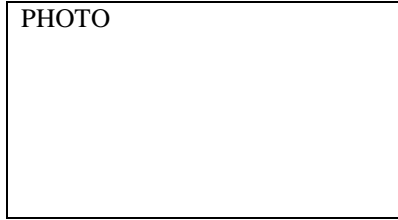
