Greetings from Yuva Parivartan!!

At present about 330 million youth in India are school dropouts with no access to other means to seek livelihood. More than 100 million are neither in employment nor in education or training (NEET)* Further a million such youth enter the workforce every month without any employable skills. Their life is one of despair, often leading to crime & delinquency. Our aim is to enable mitigation of some of these challenges.

The Yuva Parivartan movement was officially inaugurated on February 15, 2003, by the then President, Dr. A P J Abdul Kalam.

Yuva Parivartan's Mission is to work with, and enable, the poorly educated youth, by providing training to them, enabling wage work or self-employment, in urban and rural locations, in partnership with stakeholders.

The key features of our program in brief are:

- Access to all who can read and write
- Providing vocational training (70% practical & 30% theory)
- 'Soch Ka Parivartan'(SKP) – a proprietary program for confidence building and livelihood skills development
- Community Engagement, Counseling and Mentoring

Some key impacts of 'YUVA' interventions so far are:

- Total number of beneficiaries, since launch: **8,50,000**
- **70% of our beneficiaries are women**
- **91% of urban** successful beneficiaries ; **65% of rural**, are earning a living
- **52% of beneficiaries are main family wage earners**
- Over **1 lakh students** are trained per year in villages

We have embarked on two new tech-enabled projects, to raise the YUVA impact, further:

- Anytime Anywhere Learning for Anyone (AALA) – mobile app-based e-Learning platform, for skills training programs, especially designed for remote locations
- kamaai.org, a livelihood portal for access to entry level, blue collar jobs.

We appeal and seek your support for our efforts, to accelerate, to reach even larger numbers of youth.
