NOTIFICATION

On the recommendations of the Board of Management made in its 118th meeting vide item No. 4.8 and item No. 1.2 (supplementary agenda) held on 30.09.2020 and in exercise of powers vested under Sub-Section (6) and (7) of Section 54 of the HP Universities of Agriculture, Horticulture and Forestry Act, 1986 (Act No. 4 of 1987), the Chancellor of CSK Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishvavidyalaya, Palampur has been pleased to make the following amendments in the CSK Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishvavidyalaya Statutes, 1988:

65th AMENDMENT IN THE STATUTES OF CHAUDHARY SARWAN KUMAR HIMACHAL PRADESH KRISHI VISHVAVIDYALAYA STATUTES, 1988.

**Short Title : This amendment may be called CSKHPKV, Palampur
Statutes, 1988 (65th Amendment, 2020)**

Amendment/deletion/addition to Statutes 5.8 Sr. No. 56 in column No. 3 of Chapter-V and 9.28 of Chapter IX of CSK Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishvavidyalaya Statutes, 1988.

Amendment to Statute 5.8(56)

The existing provision of Statute 5.8 Sr. No. 56 in column No. 3 shall stand substituted by the following provision:

(a) Essential Qualification(s) :

- (i) Should have passed 10+2 Examination from a recognized Board of School Education/ University.

OR

Matriculation from recognized Board of School Education with one/two year's Diploma/Certificate from an Industrial Training Institute (ITI) in Information Technology (IT) & Information Technology Enabled Sectors (ITES) as notified by Director General of employment & Training (Govt. of India) from time to time or three years Diploma in Computer Engineering/Computer Science/IT from a Polytechnic as approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE):

- (ii) Computer typing speed of 30 words per minute in English or 25 words per minute in Hindi.

Provided that visually impaired persons selected/recruited under 1% quota will be exempted from acquiring Diploma in Computer Science/ Computer Application/Information Technology and passing of typing test instead they shall be imparted necessary basic training including computer training course by the Department concerned through Composite Regional Centre (CRC), Sundernagar or national Institute for the Visually Handicapped (NIVH), Dehradun or Composite Training Centre (CTC), Ludhiana. They shall have to complete the above training for which three chances will be afforded. If the incumbent fails to qualify the same his/her

services shall be terminated. However, the incumbents already in the service shall be afforded sufficient number of chances to complete the aforesaid training .

Provided further that differently abled persons who are otherwise qualified to hold clerical post as certified being unable to type, by the Medical Board, may be exempted from passing the typing test.

Explanation:- The term, "differently abled persons" does not cover visually impaired persons or persons who are hearing impaired but cover only those whose physical disability/deformity permanently prevents them from typing.


The above criteria for grant of exemption from passing the typing test shall also be applicable to the Skill Test Norms on Computers.

Amendment to Statute 9.28

The existing provision of Statute 9.28 shall stand substituted by the following provision:

A Group Saving Linked Insurance Scheme of the Life Insurance Corporation shall be introduced for the benefit of the employees of the University. This scheme shall be compulsory for all the future employees of the University. However, the existing employees will be allowed to exercise their option.

The existing scheme shall not be applicable to the employees appointed/regularized on or after 01.09.2013 as the scheme was closed by the LIC, Shimla to the new entrants from the ibid date.


