Despite of the instructions issued by the University from time to time to follow traffic rules in the University, some of the employees and students of the university are still not observing the traffic rules. It has been observed that the concerned controlling officers have not taken any strict action against the erring employees/students as per instructions.


In addition to above, the Vice-Chancellor has ordered that the Estate Officer, CSKHPKV, Palampur will arrange construction of speed humps and raised crossing at different places to encourage drivers to slow down the speed in the campus and the Statutory Officers shall display the Traffic Rules and Regulations for students/employees in the University as per **Annexure-I**.

Also as per instructions issued from time to time with regard to evacuate the stray/domestic animals from the University campus, it has also been observed that the entry of the stray/domestic animals has not yet been stopped completely. The Vice-Chancellor has viewed it seriously and ordered to adhere to the instructions issued in this regards in letter and sprit.

Now, it has been decided that the concerned controlling officer of the area will identify the entry of stray animals in the campus and necessary action to close the said entry points may be taken with the Estate Officer, CSKHPKV, Palampur. The security personnel/official deputed for watch and ward duty at Chamundeshwari Girls Hostel shall also control the entry of stray animals from main road (Highway) to the Holta residential campus. If any domestic animal is found in the University area, the concerned controlling officer will Identify the owner and will take appropriate action against him as per rules and also inform the concerned Municipal Corporation/ Ward for further action.

Therefore, all the Statutory Officers are requested to direct all the employees/students working/studying under their control to follow the traffic rules strictly as per Annexure-I. Any deviation from these rules/instructions shall be viewed seriously and the sole responsibility shall lie upon the concerned controlling officer.





**Traffic Rules and Regulations for adherence of Student/Employees/Workers/all concerned in the University Campus.**

1. All the employees/students/Project Staff/outsourced workers will wear identity card and put stickers on their vehicles while on duty in the University campus.
2. All motor vehicle rules which are enforced by the road transport authority shall be applicable inside the campus.
3. Speed limit of the vehicles will be around 30 Km per hour in the University campus
4. Bearing of helmet riding on two wheeler as well as pillar is compulsory and triple riding on two wheelers is prohibited. No student/ employee/workers will move in or out from the gates without helmet.
5. All the outsider as well as persons and unidentified vehicles entering in the University premises will make their entry in the register maintained by security staff for the purpose.
6. The identity card/driving license/RC of unidentified vehicles will have to be deposited with the security personnel while entering in the University campus and be collected back while going out from the University campus/gate.
7. Non-adherence of these instructions by any student will be liable for punishment as per Section 6.3.1 of Academic Regulation/instructions issued in this behalf.
8. Non-adherence of these instructions by any of the employee/worker etc. will be liable for action as per rules/instructions issued in this behalf.
9. If any Student/Employee/person is found indulged in violating traffic rules, the same shall be reported by the Security staff to the concerned controlling officer.
10. All the University Gates shall remain closed in off hours i.e. 6.00 PM to 9.00 AM and on each holiday. The Security personal on duty will enter Vehicles Number of each vehicle entering in the University campus during above said timing.
11. The owner of the vehicle will ensure to park their vehicles on the spaces specified for the purpose.
12. No outside person shall be allowed to park their vehicle in the University campus.
13. Permanent Parking of vehicles in the University campus shall not be allowed.
