### *About Training Programme*

Department of Veterinary and Animal Husbandry Extension Education, Dr. G. C. Negi College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Chaudhary Sarvan Kumar Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishwavidyalaya, Palampur-176062, Himachal Pradesh will be organising Five trainings of Five day each for Women in Dairy Sector under newly sanctioned project from National Commission for Women, New Delhi for the financial year 2022-23. The trainings will start from August 2022 onwards.

These trainings will be conducted to empower rural women through capacity building in livestock farming. In each training session, 30 selected farm women engaged in livestock rearing/handling activities, aged between 18-50 years with minimal literacy (5<sup>th</sup> pass or above) will be provided hands-on training on livestock farming with practical exposure.

As per training guidelines, women related to Self Help Groups and engaged in dairying & value added products or member of dairy co-operatives or women dairy farmers having two or more than two cows/buffaloes or women who have obtained from govt. institutions will be given preference. Further they must be willing and available throughout the training period.
