ACADEMIC REGULATIONS CONCERNING RAGGING

“Ragging in any form, is totally banned, within or outside the premises of the Hostels, Colleges and Departments or in any part of the CSKHPKV system as well as on roads/ transport in its vicinity.”

Any individual or collective act of ragging shall be dealt in accordance with the Academic Regulation as referred in Chapter-XVIII of Academic Regulations, 2011-12, CSKHPKV, Palampur which stipulates:

“Any act or conduct of student/students whether by words spoken or written which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher/freshers or rowdy or indiscipline activities which cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof or asking to do any act which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of fresher/freshers or to showing off power, authority or superiority on fresher/freshers” constitutes ragging. Specifically the act of ragging includes any one or more or all of the following:

- a) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- i) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.
- J) With or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Administrative and other actions in the event of ragging

One or more of the following punishments will be imposed on the ragers for violating the relevant Academic Regulations (Chapter-XVIII):

1. Cancellation of admission.
2. Suspension from attending classes
3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
4. Debaring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
5. Withholding results.

Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, and youth festival, etc.

6. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
7. Expulsion from the Institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
8. Fine of Rs.25, 000/-.
9. Collective punishment: When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
10. Depending upon the seriousness of incident of ragging, a FIR may be lodged with police. On conviction, the student/students can be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years or with fine which may extend to fifty thousand rupees or with both.
