

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All rates quoted should be F.O.R destination and should be for net packing excluding packing material, weight excluding natural but including weighing, insurance and forwarding charges. GST may be shown separately, if not mentioned the rates shall be treated as including GST. PAN, TAN, & GST No. & GST registration certificate must be mentioned/attached with tender.
2. Samples wherever required shall be submitted by the Tenderer duly signed/stamped/tagged indicating specifications, make/brand so as to reach this office by the date and time fixed for opening of tender. Samples should be sent against prepaid RRs /G.T.RS. To-pay consignments will not be entered and sample will remain undelivered with railway authorities and transport companies at the risk of the tenderer.
3. In case where full specifications are not incorporated in the inquiry or where specifications are such that the supplier cannot quote for, the supplier's own specifications should be stated in full for the articles quoted for. Any illustrative literature available, duly stamped and signed, should also accompany.
4. All containers, packing cases, bags etc. will be deemed to be non-returnable unless specifically stated otherwise in the tender.
5. All supplies should be made within stipulated period of supply order or by the date stated in the order whichever is earlier. In case it is brought to the notice of the undersigned that the supply has not been made within the prescribed period, the tender will be cancelled and earnest money will be forfeited. The university shall then be at liberty to make the purchase from any other source at supplier's risk and the University shall be free to blacklist the firm/suppliers.
6. No price increase will be allowed during the currency of rate contract and rates approved shall remain firm and fixed up to the currency of rate contract.
7. The quantity of material can be increased or decreased depending upon actual requirement/availability of funds.
8. The authorized dealers/suppliers once notified by the manufacturer/proprietors shall not be allowed to be changed in between the period of contract.
9. The inspection of goods will be carried out by the consignee at the destination and rejected goods will have to be removed by the party at its own cost within 10 days of dispatch of advice from the intending office failing which the goods will be at supplier's risk which may be disposed off by the University by public auction, if so considered.
10. All quotations/tenders should be accompanied with an earnest money @ 2% of total cost of material in the shape of FDR/DD to be pledged in the name of the Comptroller, CSKHPKV, Palampur. The tender without EMD will not be considered.
11. Performance Security will be obtained from the successful bidder @ 5% of the value of the contract in respect of each tender/bidder. Only after the deposit of Performance Security, the notification with regard to award of the tender/supply will be issued. The earnest money already deposited shall form part of performance security.
12. The supply must be completed satisfactorily within the stipulated period failing which the undersigned will have the right to purchase the goods at supplier's risk; provided that, where goods are not supplied according to the master pattern and on account of urgency of the demand, the Intending Officer decides to retain the inferior goods, the supplier will be entitled to receive payment not at the contract rate but at the price fixed by the University with due regard to the quality of the material supplied.
13. The tender may be accepted in part or whole.

14. The University reserved the right to enter into parallel rate contract with the two or more firms and to enter into negotiation with the concerned firm and to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason, if so required.
15. The rates and unit shall not be over written, amount shall be both in figures and words. The words 'NO QUOTATIONS' should be written cross all the items in the schedule for which a tenderer does not wish to tender. All correction must be signed in full by the tenderer.
16. Any dispute arising out of the deal shall be subject to the decision of the Vice-Chancellor of the University whose decision shall be final. Settlement of all disputes will be made within the jurisdiction of CSKHPKV, Palampur.
17. The undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any/all the tender without assigning any reason.
18. The signature on the quotations and samples etc. sent therewith will be deemed to be authorized signature of the tenderer.
19. The tender received after due date or without the earnest money or without samples wherever required shall stand cancelled.
20. Any term/condition given by the supplier/Firm which is in contravention to the terms contained in the tender shall not be acceptable and shall be treated as null and void.
21. In the event of tender, being accepted, the quotation will be converted into a contract which will be governed by these terms and conditions.
22. The tenders not strictly in accordance with the above conditions are liable to be rejected.
23. The tender shall be on the tender form attached herewith. The rates should be quoted against each item in the tender form. The special terms, if any, should be added on a separate sheet with tender.
24. As per order of Excise & Taxation Commissioner, Government of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla "The purchases will be preferred from the Depots / Dumps of Suppliers located in H.P."
25. The successful Tenderer will have to execute an agreement on the non-judicial paper (specimen enclosed for ready reference) duly signed and stamped.
26. Condition of advance payment or payment through cash etc. will not be considered.
27. The envelope containing tenders should be super scribed as "Tender for Supply of Poultry Feed" for the year 2022-23.
28. The rates are quoted for a specific brand and suppliers/manufactures can quote rates/bid for more than one brand separately mentioning the brand name.
29. The supply should be strictly as per the specifications.
30. Any other conditions, if any shall be announced at the time of tender opening.
31. The supplier will adhere to the provision of Motor Vehicle Act for transportation of material.
32. The conditional tender will not be entertained.
33. The firms/suppliers shall observe all the guidelines/SOPs for COVIDI-2019 prescribed by the H.P. State Govt/Central Govt. from time to time.
34. The E-way bill is to be required alongwith actual bill.
