Amendment to Statute 4.5 (3) (a)(b)(c) and (d) of CSK Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishvavidyalaya Statutes, 1988.

The following amendment will be made under Statute 4.5 (3) (a)(b)(c) and (d) of CSK Himachal Pradesh Krishi Vishvavidyalaya Statutes, 1988:-


